Shipboard interaction capabilities aboard Exploration Vessel (E/V) *Nautilus* enable students and the public to engage in a unique two-way, live dialogue with scientists, engineers, and educators of the Corps of Exploration. Live interactions are available free to classroom and community audiences thanks to the support of OET's education partners.

20 or 30 min Q&A: Dive into a conversation with Corps of Exploration presenters on E/V *Nautilus*. Learn where the ship is located and current exploration mission goals. Presenters will provide context for general audiences meeting ocean exploration for the first time and can dive deeper into the STEM elements of exploration.

Technical Requirements

- Wired internet connection (with a connection fast enough to load a video without buffering)
- Chrome browser which can connect to Google Meet (formerly Google Hangouts)
- Projector / Screen or display plan for incoming live video
- Speakers for incoming audio from presenters
- Microphone
